Dear Madam/Sir,

In relation to the public consultation "*relative au projet de règlement déterminant le plan d'allotissement et d'attribution des ondes radioélectriques (plan des fréquences) en vertu de l'article 5. (1) de la loi modifiée du 30 mai 2005 portant organisation de la gestion des ondes radioélectriques*", Inmarsat is generally pleased with the proposed revision of the national frequency plan, which takes into account, amongst other things, Decisions and Recommendations recently adopted by the Electronic Communications Committee (ECC), as this is conducive to harmonised use of the spectrum in Europe.

Inmarsat would take this opportunity to courteously remind ILR of the recent progress, at FM44 level, of the draft ECC Decision and Report on ESOMPs and to express its gratitude for the support from ILR and its representatives in the development of those documents. Inmarsat would appreciate if ILR would continue to support the finalization of the two deliverables at both WG FM and ECC level.

As the ECC adoption process is foreseen to be completed in March 2013, at the earliest, and GX services are planned to be available not long afterwards, national administration wishing to exempt ESOMPs from licensing have only a short timeframe to do so before ESOMP services are commercially available.

We would therefore like to take the occasion to request that ILR will positively consider adoption of the ESOMP decision and plan the required consultation and revisions in the national frequency plan immediately or shortly after the adoption by the ECC.

In the meantime, Inmarsat is available to provide ILR with any additional information that might be required.
